

## The Costs of a College Education

### 2023-24 Estimated Costs for Resident Students at Oklahoma Public Colleges and Universities

The average estimated cost of attending Oklahoma colleges and universities is calculated below for full-time **resident** undergraduate students enrolled in 30 semester credit hours during the 2023-24 academic year. Costs for room and board, books and supplies are based on Fiscal Year 2024 estimated costs and may be rounded to the nearest dollar.
